A: POs are self-sustaining, non-Federal entities that operate on installations, only with the written consent of an authorized approval authority. ## Q: Are we allowed to go hunting and fishing?

A: The German government allows U.S. IMCOM-Europe and U.S. Air Force Europe (USAFE) to conduct courses that allow U.S. Forces personnel to gain foreigner's hunting and fishing licenses in Germany. Volunteer US Forces personnel instruct these courses in English at IMCOM-Europe Rod & Gun Clubs.
