Special Topic: Housing Process

- DPW





Accompanied Military Personnel

In-processing

Out-processing

Who: Accompanied Personnel (all ranks; all Services)

What: Mandatory Assignment to on post

Why: IMCOM Europe Mandatory Assignment Policy

When: At PCS in

- Submit orders & application to housing to be added to waitlist
- Eligibility date is determined by the last permanent duty detachment date
- 1330 on post family housing units
- (Panzer Kaserne, Patch, Kelley, and Robinson Barracks)
 - Offer/Assignment based on availability, family size, and rank
 - ≥ 2 pets per household; must meet host nation rules
- Certificates of non-availability issued when inventory is not available

Who: All departing on post families

What: Clearing family housing

Why: To ease transition and minimize out of pocket expenses

When: At notice of PCS out

- Schedule pretermination inspection 45-60 days before departure
- Submit PCS orders; schedule final termination inspection (move out)
- Authorized 3 days of outgoing TLA starting the day of termination
- Temporary furnishings can be scheduled up to 60 days before departure and can remain in on post quarters
- Once termination is complete check into housing office to complete final clearing

Move directly into your on post home outfitted with temporary furnishings

Instant Stability for your family – one smooth transition into your home

Stress free – all paperwork completed prior to arrival

Virtual home tour – coordinated with your local sponsor prior to arrival

Unaccompanied Military Personnel

In-processing

Out-processing

Who: Mandatory Assignment applies to all Unaccompanied Personnel (with Minor Exceptions)

What: Mandatory Assignment to Barracks

Why: IAW AR 420-1, E6 and below at OCONUS locations are required to reside on the installation

- HQDA ETP for E6 Bona Fide Bachelors must receive CNA from housing
- Also applies to Geographical Bachelor Officers and E7s and above
- Rules differ for Reservists and National Guard—verify with housing before making living accommodation decisions
- · CNAs issued by housing office when inventory is not available
- · Pets are not permitted in UH
- Bonafide Bachelors (Officers / E7s and above are permitted to reside off post but must in-process with housing first
- Advise against shipping household goods
 If approved to live off post; loaner furniture will be provided

WHO: All departing Unaccompanied Housing Residents (Barracks and Bachelor Quarters)

WHAT: Clearing unaccompanied housing (UH)

WHY: At notice of PCS out

WHEN: Schedule pretermination inspection 45-60 days before departure with housing or barracks Manager (as applicable)

- · In barracks, all inspections and clearing is managed by barracks managers
- Residents of Bachelor Quarters must contact housing for clearing process upon notice of PCS
- · TLA out is not authorized for barracks residents
- Up to 3 days of TLA is authorized for bachelor housing residents

When: At PCS in, following CPF in-processing briefing

What: Off Post House Hunting

Why: Ensure community members are informed and minimize or avoid out of pocket expenses

- · Ensure properly in-processed with housing office
- View content at USAG Stuttgart Citizen App and watch applicable videos
- · Once approved, aggressively house hunt
- · Review non-referral list
- Use USAG Stuttgart Rental Contract
- · Do not sign until advised by housing
- · Ask questions

Who: All personnel authorized to live off post and receive housing services

When: At notice of departure

What: Off Post Housing Termination Process

Why: Ensure community members are informed, follow host nation protocols, and minimize out of pocket expenses

- Contact housing for termination packet and move-out protocol
- · Request loaner furniture
- Schedule Move out inspection with off post team
- Schedule pick up of furnishings and appliances
 requires a minimum of 5 business day notice
- · Authorized up to 10 days of outgoing TLA





Other Items of Community Interest

- All command sponsored active-duty family members should establish dental care within the community by utilizing the TRICARE Dental Plan. Contact United Concordia at (844) 653-4060 to enroll. Wait times for new patients on the economy can be long, so family members should establish a dental home immediately upon arriving in Germany.
- Readiness: The accuracy/efficacy of readiness status has proven less than excellent between MHS Genesis and MEDPROS. We understand that some readiness numbers feed into service-specific systems that we do not have visibility on. If you are a unit leader tracking readiness and are finding systematic issues or need solutions to improve dental readiness, please feel free to reach out to LTC Johnson.
