Requests for Garrison Support should come through the Garrison DPTMS

- Serves as a central point of contact/coordination for support (When in doubt contact us and we will try to link you up with the right people!!!!)
- Allows us to track events occurring in the community and help de-conflict competing resources



Who can create ArMA USER Account?

- Anyone with a .mil email
- Other member accounts approved by a Military or Civilian Sponsor



DA 4283s = Work Requests; Larger Construction & Repair Projects

- Includes all contract work, including user-funded contract work & must be approved prior to the contract award; aka Proprietary Approval (PA).
- 4283s are reviewed by the DPW Project Work Order Review Board (PWORB) each Wednesday
 - Validated work is added to the Annual Work Plan (<\$2M) or Facility Investment Plan (>\$2M) and prioritized (for funding & execution).
- Work can be performed as a:
 - PWO (Project Work Order) through Centerra (<\$300K)
 - Project through BAUAMT (Germany Government Contracting Agency, like USACE)
 - Project through **USACE** (US Army Corps of Engineers)
 - Proprietary Approval (PA) (Customer contracts and funds after the 4283 is Approved)
 - Ensures Building Codes are adhered to.
 - Garrison Plans and Policies are followed.
 - During construction execution, ensures QA per contract requirements & safety

Space Requests

- For space requirements of new units or existing units in addition to current allocation
- Includes requests for existing facility space as well as land area
- Requests are processed through the Master Planning Division of DPW, validated against existing plans and regulation requirements, and approved through the Real Property Planning Board.

Digging Permits

- Approval process for ground excavation exceeding 6 in / 15 cm
 - Need to start process at least 6 weeks in advance
- Package consists of digging permit request form, project approval documentation (4283, DMO, etc.), map identifying location(s) of excavation
- Package requires signatures of stakeholders (52 SIG, O&M Utilities, contractor, COR/PM) before submitting for review by Master Planning Chief. After review, final signature authority is the DPW Director.
- Approved digging permits are assigned a permit number and expiration date, and returned to the Contractor and COR/PM. If existing permit is nearing expiration, and extension request form can be submitted.

Submission Deadlines for Military Police Support

- Military Police (MP) Presence (ceremonies, special events, etc.): 10 weeks
- Military Working Dog (MWD) sweeps: 6 weeks
- Blocked Parking/Roadways: 6 Weeks
- Access Control Point/Gate openings: 12 weeks
- Firefighter support (ceremonies, special events, etc.): 8 weeks
- Host Nation Police support: 8 weeks
- Any requests that are not submitted in the above listed timeframes must include a memorandum to the DES from the first O-6 Commander/Commandant or GS-15 Director justifying why the request was submitted late.



Key Community Events <u>Europe Wide Reduction in Dental Care</u>

- <u>Primary Goal:</u> To ensure our sterilization parameters are MIFU compliant to resume over all mission of providing dental treatment to service members on active-duty orders for 30 days or more.
- · ICE Comments are encouraged.
- Limitations: Available services are dental exams, cleanings, emergency treatment as diagnosed by a Dentist, and limited restorative care.
- Operational hours: 0730-1630 Lunch: 1120-1220
- Sick Call Hours: 0720-0900

Facility / Service Closures or Changes

•There is a Europe-Wide reduction in dental care to standardize sterilization processes ordered by BG Giraud of MRC EUR/DHA EUR. Currently we can only offer dental exams, limited cleanings, emergency treatment as diagnosed by a Dentist, and limited Restorative dental care prioritized by dental readiness classification. We understand the frustration and inconvenience this causes but are bound by the directive of our Commanding General. We anticipate regular services will ramp up over the next 6+ months. Defense Health Agency has not approved any alternative treatment location on the economy to be covered by the government. Please Provide Feedback through ICE and include the major interruptions and/or health risks you experience from interruption of service. If you feel your dental needs have unique urgency not understood by our administrative staff, please request to speak with the Dental Clinic Commander, LTC Johnson.

Other Items of Community Interest

•All command sponsored active-duty family members should establish dental care within the community by utilizing the TRICARE Dental Plan. Contact United Concordia at (844) 653-4060 to enroll. Wait times for new patients on the economy can be long, so family members should establish a dental home immediately upon arriving in Germany.

•Readiness: The accuracy/efficacy of readiness status has proven less than excellent between MHS Genesis and MEDPROS. We understand that some readiness numbers feed into service-specific systems that we do not have visibility on. If you are a unit leader tracking readiness and are finding systematic issues or need solutions to improve dental readiness, please feel free to reach out to LTC Johnson.
