- A copy (front and back) of patient's > 14 y/o ID card is REQUIRED for pickup
- Controlled substances can only be filled with the patient or representative present

US Army Health Clinic provides the community flu vaccines every year. While we have already ordered this year's vaccines, we do not have an arrival date but historically we receive them mid October.

- We offer **numerous events on all kasernes** throughout the October-December season
- We will host events at **EACH** DODEA school location (flu vaccine is required by CYS and DoDEA for enrollment)
- We will **announce dates** through the clinic Facebook page, on AFN, the Citizen, MyArmyPost App, at the CLIF, and each DODEA school sends out dates in their respective newsletters. Please watch any or all of these outlets for dates and times
- **Open to all DoD ID card holders:** if you are not a regular patient of the Patch or Kelley clinic (with an assigned PCM), you and your family will need to pre-register annually with your health insurance information. This is required in order to receive any vaccine.

\*\*\*Visit the clinic Patient Administration/Medical Record office to complete the forms before heading to one of the flu events. Your compliance will help the process run smoothly and take less time.

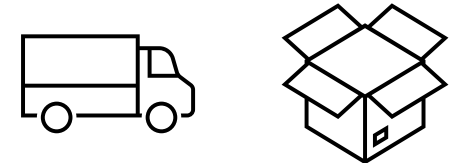

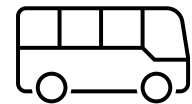

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**DoDEA Guidelines: Medication, Health Plans & Enrollment (SY 2025–2026)****Medication Administration During School Hours**

- Medication must be delivered to the school nurse in original, labeled container (name, dosage, route, time, date).
- Required form: *DoDEA Form 6000.01 (Supplement A)* signed by provider and parent.
- OTC meds also require provider-signed form.

**Self-Carry Medications (MS/HS Students)**

- Form: *DoDEA Form 6000.01 (Supplement D)*.
- PCM must provide written statement for life-threatening condition.
- Parent must give written consent.
- Backup emergency medication must be stored with nurse.

**Health Plans (IHP/ECP)**

- IHPs created by nurse with family & provider if clinically needed.
- Based on Form 6000.01 and health info; kept confidential.
- ECPs developed for chronic conditions, shared with staff on need-to-know basis.

**Immunization Requirements**

- No changes announced yet for SY 2025–2026.

**Medical Prep for New Families**

- Bring updated immunization records & sports physicals.
