







DFMWR Furlough FAQ- Child & Youth Services

Operating Status

- 1. Are Child and Youth Services Child Care locations open during the furlough? (CDC, SAC, HUB, Teen Center, etc)
- **1. Yes**, CYS are authorized to operate during a government furlough to support mission readiness

Childcare Fees

- 2. On furlough status, I may not get paid for a while, what should I expect for childcare fees?
 If both parents work full-time and still require care during the furlough, will I be assessed late fees?
- 2. Yes, parents will be responsible to pay for care.
- a. Late payments will <u>NOT</u> be assessed during the furlough period
- b. After the appropriations bill passes, families will have 30 days to pay the balance
- c. Late payments will be applied 31 days after the enactment of the appropriations bill (**Regular CYS procedures will apply after this time)

Youth Sports Fees

- 3. Youth Sports registration opens on October 15, if the furlough is still in place will I be expected to pay at the time of registration?
- **3.** <u>Yes</u>, parents will be responsible to pay for Sports and SKIES.
- a. After the appropriations bill passes, families will have 30 days to pay the balance.
- b. Children/youth enrollment(s) will be canceled at 31 days if payment is not received.



DFMWR Furlough Billing & Payment Procedures - Lodging



Billing and Payment Procedures During Government Furlough

- Option 1: Guest's Government Travel Cards (GTC) will be charged.
- Option 2: (If GTC is NOT an option)
 - 1. FMWR requires contact information of the guest to have on file, including Unit information.
 - 2. FMWR places their bill in a direct bill status (holding account).
 - 3. For guests <u>already</u> staying in lodging, charges will be tracked.
 - 4. Once the appropriations bill has been passed, guests will have <u>30</u> days to settle their bill at lodging.

Additional Services

8 Oct 2025

- Below you will find helpful guidance for any Service Members that may require financial support during the government shutdown.
- The Air Force, Navy-Marine Corps and Army aid societies highly encourage households to seek assistance first from their financial institutions.
- Some financial institutions are offering assistance programs:
 - Navy Federal Credit Union will allow eligible members to enroll in its Paycheck Assistance Program.
 - USAA is offering no-interest loans and special insurance payment arrangements.
 - o First Command offers qualifying customers interest-free pay advance loans and penalty-free early CD withdrawals.
 - o PenFed Credit Union offers its affected members zero-interest loans covering a paycheck.
 - Andrews Federal Credit Union has short-term loans, penalty-free early withdrawals from Share Certificates and counseling available to its affected members.
- Major commercial banks are not currently offering financial relief programs. But if the shutdown lasts a long time, it may be
 worth checking again <u>during the last shutdown</u>, Wells Fargo, Bank of America, Chase and Citi offered some assistance.
- The Air Force Aid Society is not currently accepting applications for assistance directly related to the shutdown as Oct. 1
 paychecks were still issued, according to a <u>notice posted on its website</u>. But if the shutdown continues to the point that Oct. 15
 paychecks are disrupted, AFAS will issue new guidance. Its normal application process continues as normal.
- The <u>Navy-Marine Corps Relief Society</u> does not have a special program for those affected by the shutdown, but its offices will be open during normal hours to assist those affected.
- <u>Army Emergency Relief</u> says it will provide zero-interest loans in the event the Oct. 15 paycheck is disrupted, equivalent to the amount of one net paycheck up to a maximum of \$6,000. Soldiers who believe they will be in financial distress if they do not receive pay on Oct. 15 or later are advised to create an account and apply online.
- Coast Guard Mutual Assistance is offering an interest-free loan that covers up to one month of Basic Allowance for Housing.
- If Service Members experience financial hardship after October 15th due to the government shutdown, they are highly encouraged to speak to their chain of command in order to seek guidance

 - Estimated Completion Date: October 2027


