





DPW: 100% Housing Inspection

Mandatory Third-Party Housing Inspections

What: A **Congressionally mandated**, third-party inspection of <u>ALL</u> Army Family Housing and Executive Housing to ensure all Army's housing assets are safe and habitable.

Who: The Army has contracted experienced, certified home inspectors who passed a rigorous background.

When: 6-16 JAN 2026

Where: The entire perimeter and interior rooms of each house or unit. Inspectors will take multiple photos both outside and inside the home. They will be careful to not photograph residents, personal photos, or pets.

What will they inspect: All building systems and a survey of easily visible and readily accessible elements like the roof; gutters and downspouts; house façade; exterior of windows; foundations, walkways, driveways; porches, patios and stairs; and landscaping and site gradient. All smoke detectors will be activated without exception.

Who long will the inspection take? The inspection should take about 60 minutes but may take up to two hours.

What do I need to do? All Army Family Housing and Executive Housing residents MUST schedule an inspection appointment through the online portal no later than 31 DEC 25.

This inspection is mandatory.

Schedule your appointment early to prevent chain of command from getting involved.



DPW: More About the Inspections

Preparing for your inspection

- ✓ Be at home and ready for the inspection at the beginning of the start time to help inspectors stay on schedule
- ✓ Put pets away during the inspection.
- ✓ Ensure inspector have access to <u>ALL</u> interior spaces, including the garage.
- ✓ Inspectors will test <u>ALL</u> smoke detectors. Do not request inspectors skip this important EHS protocol.
- ✓ Inspectors will take photos but will avoid taking photos of people, pets or personal belongings.

Escorted Inspections

- If a resident does not schedule an inspection before **29 DEC 25**, the Housing Office will schedule an *escorted inspection*. Housing will send a 48-hour notification letter to the resident, and Army personnel will act as escorts for the entire inspection.
- If a resident refuses entry to an inspector, the resident's chain of command will be contacted, and the inspection will proceed as an escorted inspection.

Right to Enter

- The Army has the legal right to enter any residence on the installation for any legal purpose.
- That right extends to Army contractors and Army personnel acting as escorts who are tasked to enter and inspect housing.

- system designed to record the entry and exit of non-EU nationals traveling to and from the Schengen Area for short stays, including those who do not require a visa. EES is a digital on-arrival registration system that will replace the traditional passport stamping.
- If you are here on a SOFA status, you are exempt from registering into EES.
- When traveling, we strongly encourage you and your family carry your passports, DoD-issued IDs, and orders showing that the service member (or sponsor) and command sponsored families are on a SOFA status.
- If, by chance, you get enrolled in EES,
 contact the Stuttgart Legal Center for assistance in disenrolling in the system.





AHC Stuttgart: Questions

QUESTION: Are there medications that the pharmacy has already run out and what meds are anticipated to be done soon?

- What options are available to patients, if their medication runs out?
- If a patient seeks to get their medication off-post, will they get reimbursed for the cost of the medication when the shutdown is over?

QUESTION: I am concerned about capacity of local providers to see Tricare beneficiaries in timely manner. How can we communicate this to Tricare and either get Tricare to expand its in network providers or treat this area as a remote location allowing beneficiaries to work more directly with ISOS and find more easily find providers without having to wait for PCM appointments and take up more PCM time with requests for referrals when they could be seeing patients.





AAFES: Questions

COMMENT: As launderettes are updated, please consider keeping air dryers and 30-minute washing machines/top loaders. Most people using these facilities come because it is the fastest way to get laundry done and the ability to use American standard machines. Also, instructions should be in clear American English, so people know how to use the machines.

ANSWER: These are commercial machines. The vendor's machines will have different programs to choose from, including an express program with a maximum duration of 30 minutes per wash cycle.





DoDEA: Questions

QUESTION: The Stuttgart High School Rifle/Marksmanship Team was notified on 10 Nov 25 that only team members who enrolled in the JROTC program/class will be allowed to participate on the team. Students who joined and practiced on the team have now been excluded due to a requirement that was not a prerequisite at the start of the season.

An exception to policy (ETP) has been submitted on behalf of the students who are not currently enrolled in JROTC. What can be done to take care of our students?

ANSWER: This decision was made to comply with funding requirements. However, it is not the intention to exclude students who were already participating. DoDEA will work with affected students to allow them to participate.





DHR: Questions

QUESTION: How are the mailrooms going to adjust to meet the holiday pickup? Is there capacity for a staff shift to accommodate RB to have a few days of outgoing packages?

ANSWER: The garrison was approved to hire seasonal workers to help control lines at the package pick-up windows. These employees are limited in what duties they can perform in the post offices. They can't be a finance clerk for shipping out packages as they must be trained, and they are only with us for 90 days. Hours this year cannot be extended. This is Europe wide.

Unfortunately, currently we cannot shift employees as we are still undermanned and running on minimal staffing at all locations.

QUESTION: Do you accept volunteers at the post office for APO and/or CMR? ANSWER: CMR/PSCs can accept volunteers, but we are at capacity with borrowed military manpower right now. APOs cannot accept volunteers as there are different requirements to work the APOs.





DES: Questions

COMMENT: I think it really a problem at Vehicle Registration with this system and the waiting time. The app causes situations with maybe you phone goes out or something. There should be a board or screen for people to see when it's their turn. Losing a whole day from work to do this is really bad, and the staffing is short. But the appointment is too long out.

ANSWER: We will investigate potential system glitches.

QUESTION: Is there an enforcement solution that would better protect parking spots in front of the Patch Post Office? I understand parking on Patch is terrible. Though the blue parking signs are posted in front of that strip for 30-minute parking, it's never enforced.

ANSWER: The newest garrison parking policy focuses on some of our enforcement options. We hope that alleviates some of the parking problems but recognize that parking on Patch continues to be a pain point.

QUESTION: When will the new gate by the construction of the new Robinson elementary school on Roter Stitch open? Is there any plan to allow RB community members to utilize this gate or is it solely for construction vehicles? Is there a plan to have a second gate on Robinson in the future?

ANSWER: The newly added construction gate at Robinson Barracks is specifically placed to support the elementary school construction project which will take several years to complete. This entrance was funded as part of the construction project to reduce risk for the community and alleviate traffic congestion as much as possible. Access is restricted to construction vehicles only. This is driven by safety and contractual requirements.

The garrison's Directorate of Emergency Services, the Safety Office and DPW looked at traffic flow and safety concerns. Based on the traffic survey along with best industrial safety practices it was determined that construction traffic would only utilize the ACP.

We fully appreciate the impact and driving delays construction projects cause, however safety of our community and risk mitigation is one of our priorities. We appreciate your patience throughout the construction period and asked for your continued support with our community improvements.

COMMENT: Kids playing on the track at Patch is an issue. Service members are trying to PT and take their PT tests, but kids throw their backpacks all over the track and play in the running lanes.

ANSWER: It takes a village. If you see minors behaving badly, say something. If the situation escalates, you can reach out to the MPs but this is our collective community.



DES: Questions

- 1. ANSWER: We continue to refine the registration process with the goal of lowering customer time spent on this required task. Technical solutions are being implemented with the intent of streamlining the processes and ease of access for all customers. The VRO has implemented a screen to more easily inform customers of their place in line. We concur that registering your vehicle should not take an entire day. We ask you to assist us by ensuring you are prepared and have all the required information with you when you arrive. We strive to provide the best services possible and appreciate your feedback.
- 2. ANSWER: There really is no one fix for community members to do the "Right Thing" and follow posted parking signs. The MP Patrols do their best to catch violators and do write citations to those they catch violating parking regulations. The Garrison Parking Policy #10 has been updated as of 27 October 2025. The Policy added specific penalties for individuals caught violating parking statues multiple times. Parking violations are enforced, unfortunately we do not catch all violations all the time. Thank you for your feedback, it is appreciated.
- 3. ANSWER: The ACP in support of the Robinson Barracks construction project was scheduled to open on 17 NOV 2025, due to material delivery challenges the opening of the "Construction" gate is currently delayed. Once we have an estimated opening date the community will be informed.
- 4.ANSWER: The newly added "Construction Gate" at Robinson Barracks is specifically placed to support the Elementary School construction project which will take several years to complete. This ACP was funded as part of the construction project to reduce risk for the community and alleviate traffic congestion as much as possible. Access will be restricted to construction vehicles only; this is driven by safety and contractual requirements. Garrison Directorate of Emergency Services, the Safety Office and DPW looked at traffic flow and safety concerns. Based on the traffic survey along with best industrial safety practices it was determined that construction traffic would only utilize the ACP. We fully appreciate the impact and driving delays construction projects cause, however safety of our community and risk mitigation are one of our priorities. We appreciate your patience throughout the construction period and asked for your continued support with our community improvements.
- 5. ANSWER: There is not a current plan to add a second gate to RB in the future. Access Control Points are authorized and manned based on traffic volume / flow and requirements. Unfortunately, additional gates require increased funding and staffing, which is currently not feasible.





DFMWR: Questions

QUESTION: Can private organizations, linked to USAG Stuttgart, receive an exemption for:

- 1. 30-day fundraising application
- 2. 2 fundraisers per quarter max, if they are hosting a fundraiser(s) and/or gifts in kind collection to go directly to support those impacted by the shutdown? No Longer Applicable

ANSWER:

- **Fundraiser Limit:** Private Organizations (POs) may submit **eight** fundraiser requests per fiscal year.
- Late Submission Waiver Requests: POs may submit a late waiver once a year.
- Minimum Notice: No requests will be granted if the event date is less than 10 days away
- **Multiple Events Policy:** Continuous fundraisers or multiple dates/locations with the same concept are considered one event and must be submitted as a single fundraiser request.

QUESTION: When will the "Nautilus" Room at Patch Gym reopened?

ANSWER: Equipment has arrived in Germany, pending delivery to USAG Stuttgart. Once we receive the equipment, we will install the equipment at Patch, Kelley, and RB fitness centers.





DPW: Questions

QUESTION: Some buildings without balconies and Rolladen are being measured for them. Will they be installed while residents actively live in those buildings? If so, how long is the expected installation process for each? And when would the work begin?

ANSWER: Work is ongoing based on funding. It is occurring in all units.

While installation yard maintenance is suspended during the shutdown, can the installation loan out for FREE equipment for individuals to help maintain shared spaces? *Most on-post residences do not have yard tools to maintain yard spaces and parks and they do not want to purchase tools specifically for this.

Self Help can loan out small tools. However, there is not enough equipment to have loaner mowers or other large machines.

COMMENT: Other garrisons in Europe offer free-cycle areas where community members may donate (or obtain) items that are not normally donated to the thrift store, like used lawn mowers, gas cans, leftover paint and petroleum products that can't be shipped in household goods nor donated to thrift. Additionally, other garrisons offer recycling of used oil, paints, scrap metal bins, scrap wood bins, non-working appliance bins for both on-base residents and non-on base residents. It is important to note that recycled metal often has a monetary value.

ANSWER: LRC (B2956 at Panzer) currently only accepts HAZMAT (paints, glues, cleaners, disinfectants, aerosols, sealants, oils and new printer/toner cartridges) from Units/Organizations which must be submitted with their respective Safety Data Sheets and unopened. LRC no longer collects household substances nor off post items. DPW Environmental Division works to convey this information to the community in our HM/HW awareness trainings. As for scrap metal, wood and appliances, the DPW waste yards at Kelley, Panzer, Patch, and RB manage that aspect for drop off or can be scheduled for a bulk pickup. Contact your ICs for assistance.





DPW: Questions

PATCH

QUESTION: Can anything be done about the teachers taking the parking spots of barracks residents' parking spots on Patch?

ANSWER: Resident parking is only for residents. If you see a violation, contact the MPs for enforcement.

ROBINSON

COMMENT: The corner of Leutenbacher and Schlichtener Str on Robinson (where the newest apartments are) needs a yield sign. People coming up from the 300s or leaving 189 do not yield and there has already been multiple close calls of people almost hitting each other.

ANSWER: A Yield Sign has been placed with a temporary footing as of Wednesday, 12 NOV 25. A DMO (CS5121104) has been submitted to for our DPW In-House Shops to complete the permanent placement.

QUESTIONS:

- Can you repaint all the parking lot numbers on Robinson?
- At Robinson Barracks some of the housing parking spaces have been renumbered, but the new space numbers do not match the previous ones. There has been no guidance or information from housing on if this was an error or if we have been reassigned new spaces permanently. Do you have any information on this?
- Why is DPW painting parking lot numbers?

ANSWER: All building numbers on parking spaces are in the process of being repainted. However, the recent weather has been prohibitive.

COMMENT: We need large swings for teens on Robinson. The teens love swings and people get so upset that the teens use the small swings. We need large swings for them.

ANSWER: This is great feedback! Each year we look for projects to improve quality of life for our residents. These smaller requests are easy for us to make happen. We will add this to our planning list, however we are at liberty of funds approval and distribution from our higher headquarters. In the meantime, we welcome additional information on specific locations. Please provide to the housing chief, Ms. Bates directly.



DPW: Questions

QUESTION: The speed bumps on Robinson Barracks are larger than other speed bumps on Patch and damage to vehicles. Can this be corrected?

ANSWER: RB speed bumps have been designed and constructed per German/US code. They meet the requirement of slowing down vehicles to a very slow speed across the site.

QUESTION: Why is the DPW contractor occupying space on Patch? Their small repair trams, as well as personal vehicles, consume lots of space. Seems like they could be off base.

ANSWER: DPW's contractor is contractually obligated to have space to store their supplies and offices. They fully use all the space provided to them and could probably fill more space if we gave it to them. This may be alleviated soon with some of the space being freed up on Panzer.





Housing: Questions

QUESTION: Is there a second evacuation route for those families in stairwells without balconies? Check on fireproofing housing doors as they are not all secure. Some have gaps on the bottom.

ANSWER: It is not recommended that families attempt to exit higher floors without the assistance of professionals. In the event of a fire the doors provide immediate shelter. The doors on the units are fire rated to 90 minutes. Most family housing units also have sprinkler systems. Units that don't will during planned renovation. Additionally, fire trucks are equipped to help people safely exit higher floors. If you have concerns regarding the security of fire doors, fire safety can conduct an inspection. Please contact the housing office at USAG-Stuttgart-Housing-BLDG-PM@army.mil to make a request.





RSO: Questions

QUESTION: Can individuals donate to the chaplain's office money or commissary gift cards so that chaplains can give out gift cards?

ANSWER: Yes, the Chaplain's Office may accept donations. We recommend providing monetary contributions as outlined on the previous slide. Donations can be made through the PushPay app at **pushpay.com/g/stuttgartgive**. Please select the sub-account **CAJY** to support the Operation Helping Hand gift card program.

Product donations to the pantries can be made at any time right at the pantry.

The items needed most include hygiene items, diapers, and pasta sauce but the need changes. There is a sign by the pantries noting what is needed the most at that time.





Stuttgart Legal Center: Questions

QUESTION: As the shutdown continues and GS employees are not receiving their full pay, can GS (or any Federal Employee) receive an ETP towards the Joint Ethics Regulations ruling on \$20 dollar gift in kind/monetary donations. *Many individuals and/or private organizations would like to be able to support community members who are critically impacted by the shutdown but are told that they cannot give federal employees more than \$20 (even if it's a gift card to the commissary).

ANSWER: An employee may accept a gift given by an individual under circumstances which make it clear that the gift is motivated by a family relationship or personal friendship rather than the position of the employee. Relevant factors in making such a determination include the history and nature of the relationship and whether the family member or friend personally pays for the gift.





Additional Questions

QUESTION: What is the status on the garrison's cleaning contract for office spaces?

ANSWER: Funds should start flowing and contracts should be paid soon with services resuming within the week.

QUESTION: With the garrison announcing a pet policy is in review should garrison employees be turning away customers who enter facilities with pets?

ANSWER: Yes. We are developing a new policy that will reiterate that our workplaces follow federal law. Pets are not allowed in federal buildings.

QUESTION: What is enforcement of the new parking policy going to look like?

ANSWER: Enforcement will start with a verbal warning and then progress from there. A ticket, points, towing, and even a temporary or suspension of USAREUR-AF licenses are all possible based on the frequency and severity of violations.

TRICARE Plus is a service-directed primary care empanelment program available at select military treatment facilities (MTFs).

The ability to offer the TRICARE Plus program is based on capacity, capability, and mission. Offering TRICARE Plus creates a partnership between the community and the MTF. It enhances our team's readiness skills while improving primary care access to the community. This benefits TRICARE Plus members, clinicians, and active-duty service members.

Enrollment in TRICARE Plus guarantees only a primary care provider. Specialty care is neither dependent on nor guaranteed by PLUS enrollment. Based on capacity availability or constraints, specialty care can be accessed by those not enrolled in PLUS, and it may not be available to those who are. The primary mission of Landstuhl Regional Medical Center (LRMC) is to support the health and readiness of our active-duty population and their family members. We value our TRICARE-eligible beneficiaries and strive to increase and improve available services.

THINGS TO KNOW

APPLICANTS

The program may be modified, restricted, or closed to future TRICARE Plus applicants. Current TRICARE Plus members may be removed due to changes in capacity, capability, or mission.

SPECIALTY CLINICS

Enrollment in TRICARE Plus does not guarantee access to local MTF specialty clinics (e.g., cardiology, orthopedics, behavioral health). TRICARE Plus enrollment is not required to make appointments with specialty clinics whose availability status is "open" to the requesting patient's beneficiary status.



ELIGIBILITY

TRICARE Plus consideration is available for retirees, retiree family members, non-command sponsored Active-Duty Family Members (ADFMs), and command sponsored dependent parents.

RESTRICTIONS

The local MTF commander has specified the following restrictions in TRICARE Plus enrollments:



Eligible personnel must apply to participate, and if approved, they will only be guaranteed primary care at the facility to which they are empaneled.



TRICARE Prime eligible command sponsored ADFMs and TRICARE Young Adult Select are not authorized enrollment into the TRICARE Plus program.



The patient should not reside more than 100 kilometers away from enrolled MTF.*



By signing the TRICARE Plus enrollment form, the patient agrees to be seen by their local primary care provider at least once every 12 months.

*Patients who reside outside of 100 kilometers from their local MTF may be enrolled if space is available.



ENROLLMENT PERIOD

The local TRICARE service center will accept applications throughout the enrollment period from Nov. 3, 2025, through Dec. 15, 2025. After Dec. 15, the enrollment period will close, and applications will not be accepted.

PRIORITY

Priority will be given to beneficiaries whose medical needs align with the readiness of the local MTF primary care providers and support staff. An Order of Merit List (OML) will be created for empanelment up to the predetermined capacity.

Please follow LRMC on Facebook or visit our website at https://landstuhl.tricare.mil, where we will provide directions along with a QR code on Nov. 3 on how to apply for the program. Application into the program does not guarantee enrollment. Enrollment letters will be sent out to those selected after the program has closed.







Stuttgart 2025-2026 Influenza Campaign

MTF Influenza Vaccine Eligibility:

- 1. Participating individuals need to be registered with MHS Genesis. This will allow the MTF to document the vaccine in accordance with DHA.
 - a. To register, please visit the clinic Patient Administration office 0730-1200 Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday; 0730-1400 Wednesday and Friday.
- 2. Completion of the Influenza Screening Form, DHA 116 v JUL 2025, for each individual receiving the vaccine. The influenza vaccine is recommended for everyone 6 months and older.

Good to Know:

- Influenza vaccines will only be offered during the scheduled events listed.
- Walk-ins for influenza vaccine will ONLY be available during the scheduled events, or by appointment in the clinic after the campaign events.
- 3. The influenza vaccine is a requirement for active-duty military and CYS personnel.
 - a. Please refer to each individual organization for their deadline.
- 4. Youths 15-17 years of age may receive the flu vaccine without a parent/guardian present. They will need their DoD ID and meet eligibility criteria listed above. Screening will be done by a provider.
- We encourage families to bring a "special" band-aid, comfort item and/or treat for your little one(s) for a tolerable experience.

Consider the following recommendations to protect yourself, your family, and your community before, during, and after a respiratory infection.

Precaution and Prevention Strategies

- Individuals who are exhibiting symptoms of an infectious respiratory disease, including colds, influenza, and COVID-19, should not come to the workplace or conduct official travel until symptoms have begun to resolve. Symptoms of an infectious respiratory disease may include fever, body aches, cough, runny nose, sore throat, vomiting, or diarrhea.
- Negative test results are not required for individuals who have recently recovered from a respiratory infection to return to the workplace or to conduct official travel.
- Individuals who have recently recovered from a respiratory infection should consider wearing a mask in the workplace for 10 full days following initial symptoms.



Candidates can filter job searches by location, salary, work schedule or agency to narrow their results. Review Job Opportunity Announcements and follow the instructions on what the required documents are and how to apply. You will submit your application and questionnaire in USAJobs to the agency for consideration. Candidates can check the status of their application at any time through their USAJobs account.

Applications will be adjudicated once the job announcement closes to determine qualifications and preference eligibility. The hiring manager will conduct interviews and vet the qualified referred applicants for final selection.

Educator/Teaching Positions

Employment Application System (EAS) is a web-based system that allows professional educators seeking employment with the Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) the ability to submit and manage their applications in an online environment 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and 365 days a year.

Candidates may apply for Classroom Teacher, School Guidance Counselor, School Nurse, School Psychologist, Physical Therapist, Occupational Therapist, and Speech Language Pathologist positions via EAS at: https://webapps.dodea.edu/EAS/loqin.cfm.

Once a new application is started, candidates will complete ten modules of information and preferences before finalizing their application. In the Target Jobs Module, candidates can choose the positions they are interested in for consideration. In the Target Location Module, candidates can identify the geographic locations they want to be considered for.

DoDEA requires that successful candidates meet Minimum Academic Preparation and Requirements, Candidates must be a U.S. citizen and possess a minimum of a bachelor's degree with specific coursework requirements in the specialty area they are applying. Applicants are required to provide a photocopy of all official transcripts indicating what type of degree and the date it was conferred, as well as a current valid state teaching/counseling certificate. Document Services & Mass Production

TSAE does not provide document reproduction or copier services such as document printing, business cards, or products that are available for order on Army Electronic Pubs (AE PUBS).

Maps

Soldiers should order maps via their unit map custodian, normally the S-2 is designated to perform this function. For maps in the Army system, the Map Support Office (MSO) at Germersheim, part of the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA), can handle large requests from your maps custodian. GIS map requests will be submitted to ITAMIAW with TSAE policy. The TSC is not a source for printing maps. The TSC can produce some special/custom maps not already in the Army system, or available with ITAM, in limited quantities. In most locations the TSC's ITAMKIOSK is available to Soldiers for free use.

Graphic Training Aids

Numbered GTAs will not be reproduced at the TSC. Several GTAs are on stock or are available for order through the TSC.

Event Programs & Posters

Any one-time event, or an event that is on a specific date and time, will not be supported.

Non-Army work or Training Related

Only products to support daily Army work and Army training will be produced.

7th ATC: New VIO Request Process

HOW TO SUBMIT A AESMP WORK REQUEST

- Go to https://www.aesmp.armv.mil/csm.
- 2. Click on the I accept button. (If new to website, choose log in with PKI)
- 3. Login by inputting your CAC pin.
- 4. Select the Get Something option (shopping
- 5. Select the Visual Information Ordering System option.
- 6. Choose Type of product:
- » For all studio photos, select the VIOS Photography hyperlink.
- » Next to Type of Photography, select the appropriate photography type; head and shoulders for command / leader board photos.
- » Due to DAPMIS sunsetting 31 July 2025, any VI activity CONUS and OCONUS is unable to capture and process official DA Photos in their photo studios.
- » For photo coverage of official events, select Photography of Special Event.
- » To request prints of any file, select VIOS Graphic Design and Production.
- » For graphic design requests, select VIOS Graphic Design and Production.
- » To request Video recording of an official event, select VIOS Videography and Audio Request.
- » To request audiovisual equipment (i.e. microphones and speakers), select VIOS Audiovisual Equipment Loan & Support.
- » To request fabrication services (i.e. training aids) select VIOS Fabrication.
- » Newborn passport photos are by appointment only.
- 7. Fill out the information for the work order request, ensuring that all asterisk-marked* fields are filled in correctly.
- 8. Click the Submit button. You will then be taken to the AESMP My Request portal for the request. You can track your request at https://www.aesmp.army.mil.

Production will start after the funds are transferred.

GRAPHIC DESIGN

The graphics section provides design services. printing, laminating & mounting, and self help support for training purposes.

All graphic service needs are taken by appointment only and can be scheduled online at https://www.aesmp.armv.mil/csm.

All products have a 2 week turn around time! If a longer time is required, you will be notified.

If you have fabrication requests such as wooden display boards—these are forwarded to TAPC in Grafenwoehr.

Lamination and Mounting

When putting in a work request remember to indicate if you need your prints laminated or mounted on foamboard or posterboard. Only permanent or reusable signs are mounted.

Design Services
