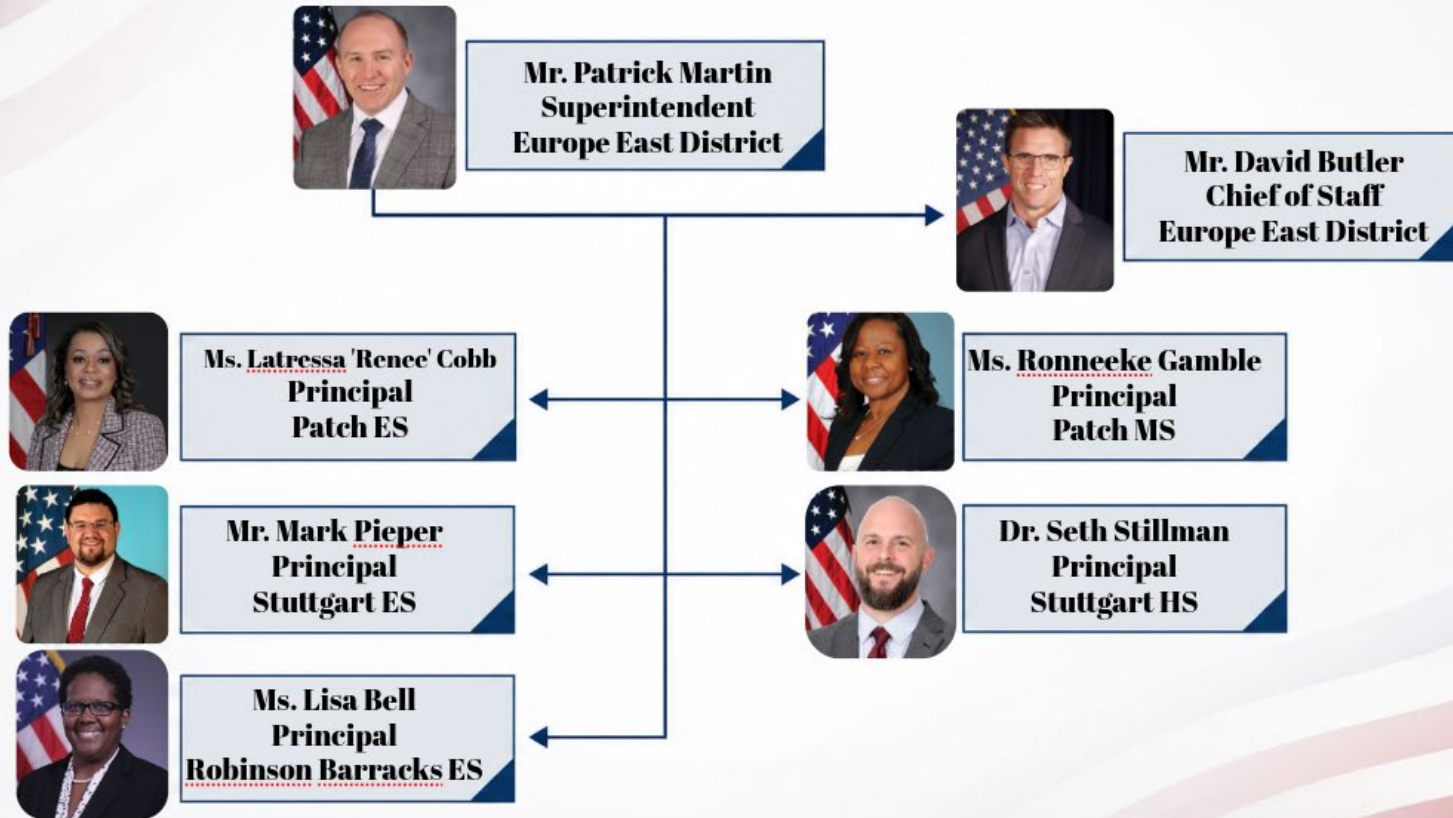

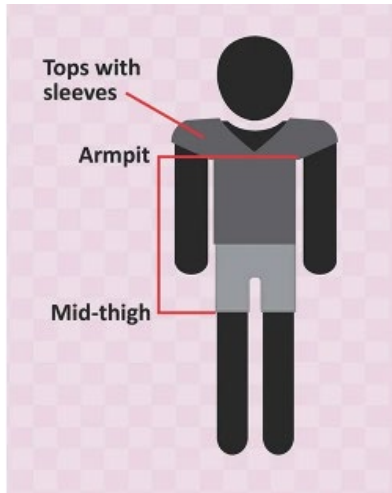

Student Cell Phone & Personal Device Policy (SY 2026–2027)

Beginning in the 2026-2027 school year, students will not be permitted to use personal portable electronic mobile devices (e.g., smartphones, smartwatches, tablets, Bluetooth devices, and internet-enabled gaming devices) during the school day. Devices must remain turned off or silenced and securely stored from the start of the school day until dismissal. Exceptions apply for approved medical needs, Section 504 plans, IEPs, and authorized instructional activities. Students may contact home through a school telephone with staff approval. This policy is intended to minimize distractions and promote a focused, safe, and productive learning environment.

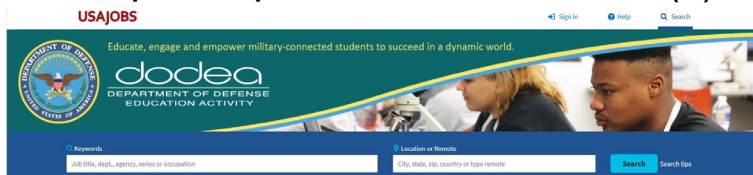

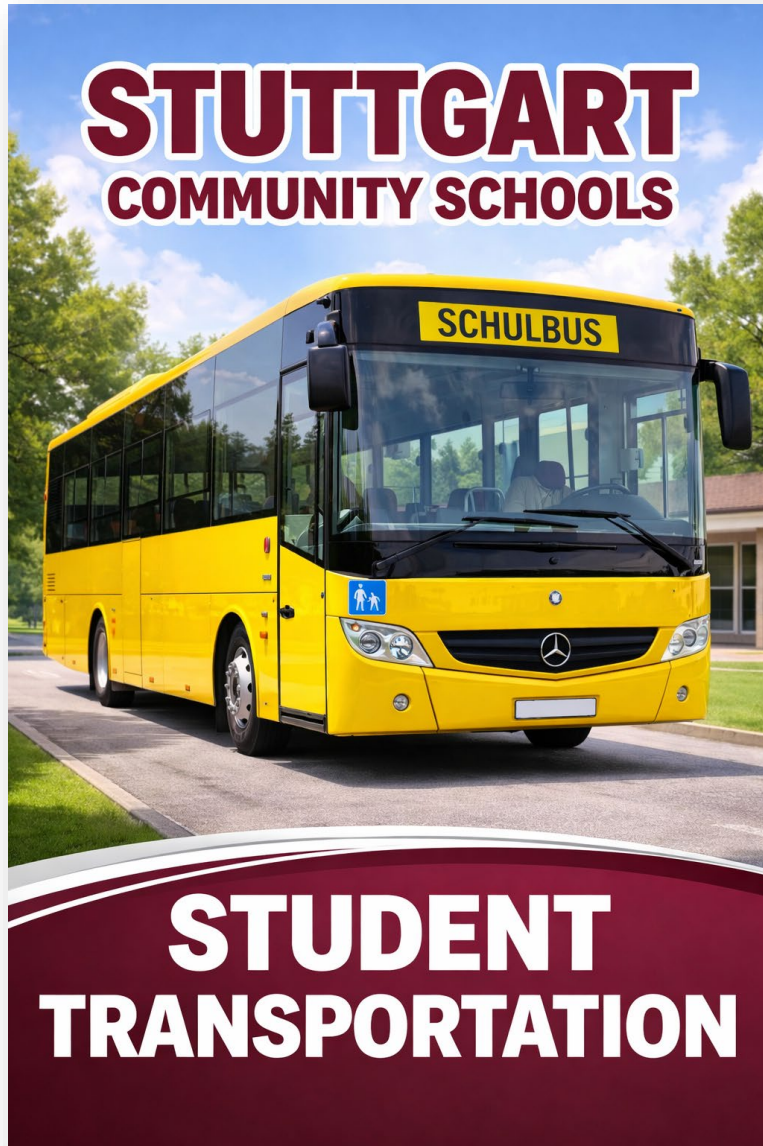

- Patch Main Gate reopening **Delayed to September**
 - The main gate will reopen with enhanced security features.
 - Gate Access Control Features: 3 inbound lanes, 1 outbound lane, pedestrian access, active DBIDS for visitor and identity/authorization confirmation (manual look up).

- **Facility / Service Closures or Changes**

- Swabian Gate closure and continued construction
 - The Swabian gate was constructed as a limited use gate.
 - Continued construction will establish permanent force protection features, structures for Contract Security Guards (CSG), and active DBIDS.
 - IMCOM-Europe manages the CSG contract for all US Army Garrisons; insufficient traffic circulation and installation access throughput does not support an increase to USAG Stuttgart CSG population to open the Swabian gate.

- **Other Items of Community Interest**

- US European Command (USEUCOM) Designated Country List expansion
 - Increases the list of countries and its citizens prohibited entry to all US military installations in Europe or requiring enhanced security screening by USAREUR-AF G2.
 - An Exception to Policy process has been established to support mission partner and community requests.
 - Requestors must coordinate with the Installation Access Control Office No Later Than (NLT) **60 days** from the requested access date to ensure USAREUR-AF G2 screening and Garrison Commander denial or approval.

- **Local National Security Process (LNSP)**

- LNSP provides a background check for Local National employees, contractors, and other authorized users of U.S. Army installations in Germany.
- USAREUR-AF G2 manages the program; employers/supervisors/Contracting Officer Representatives (CoR) are responsible for Local Nationals enrollment in the LNSP online system of record and appropriate document submission.
- Garrison Security Office can assist with answering questions.

Bottom Line Up Front (BLUF):

- NEW: We have received limited authorizations to hold 4 MSF courses. Dates are TBD. Regularly check the AIRS website for opportunities to participate.
- *Due to a critical FY26 budget shortfall, all Army-sponsored Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF) had been halted.*
- *The requirement to present a current MSF Advanced Rider Course (ARC) completion card for motorcycle registration is deferred for Army Service Members only due to limited courses.*
- *This temporary suspension expires on December 1, 2026.*

-
- **Army Commanders (O-3 and above):** Are authorized to approve temporary ARC deferrals via Memorandum for Record (MFR).
 - **No Waiver of Licensing:** Standard licensing requirements remain in effect. Soldiers must stay fully licensed and insured.

Commander's Responsibility: Must ensure deferred riders participate in the unit's Motorcycle Mentorship Program (MMP) and enforce 100% Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) compliance.

Registration Requirements During This Period:

- Army Service Members must present the following to the VRO/DTTS:
- A valid state-issued driver's license with a motorcycle endorsement.
- Their most recent MSF card (e.g., Basic RiderCourse).
- A Commander-signed MFR documenting the temporary ARC training deferral.



Note: This policy change applies STRICTLY to U.S. Army Service Members within the USAREUR-AF footprint. Members of other service branches (USAF, USN, USMC) must continue to follow their respective service-specific requirements.
